In our assessment of the 2023-24 Districtwide Climate Survey, we have recently updated our Code of Conduct and Discipline Matrix to ensure that disciplinary measures are applied equitably across all schools. While this matrix is designed to foster fairness, it is essential to understand that we take student discipline very seriously. Each incident undergoes a thorough investigation prior to any decisions being made.

It is also important to highlight that disciplinary actions are confidential; details are shared only with the involved student(s) and their caregiver(s). We do not disclose the outcomes of other students' cases to anyone outside of their immediate families.
